Mr. S. Ananda Kumar Retires



After nearly four decades of dedicated service, **Mr. S. Ananda Kumar,** Senior Engineer, retires from Christian Medical College Vellore, leaving behind a legacy marked by professional excellence, spiritual depth, and a Christ-centred approach to leadership and teamwork. Mr. Ananda Kumar joined CMC Vellore in 1985 as a Junior Engineer. Over the next 38 years, he became a pillar of the Engineering Department, overseeing numerous construction, renovation, and upgrade projects across the campus. His work included the renovation of Hospital wards, the ENT theatre, the Lithotripsy unit, the Surgical ICU, and the Chapel. He played a key role in constructing the Betatron Machine Block in the Radiotherapy Department and upgrading vital service areas such as Laundry, CSSD, and Dietary.

Dr. Findlay was former Principal and
Professor of Surgery at CMC Vellore.

He also extended his service to mission hospitals like the Reynolds Memorial Hospital, Washim—where he led planning and repair works, including the operation theatre and sewage treatment plant—and the CSI Hospital, Erode, where he assisted in major theatre renovations and general repairs. Throughout, he worked in close collaboration with the CMC engineering heads, offering not just technical strength but a consistent spirit of teamwork and humility.

In 2020, Mr. Ananda Kumar moved to the CMCV Chittoor Campus as Senior Engineer, where he led the entire spectrum of engineering services—including Civil, Electrical, Mechanical, Biomedical, AC, BME, CHIPS, Environmental, and Communication systems. Under his leadership, key infrastructure projects were executed, such as the construction of the Eye Theatre, the development of the South OPD Block, and the upgrading of the sewage treatment plant. During the COVID-19 pandemic, his calm and efficient leadership was critical in rapidly establishing the SARI ward and arranging oxygen pipelines and concentrators. He also oversaw renovation works, supported lift installations, and even developed a play area for staff children, bringing a personal and compassionate dimension to his role.

One of his standout contributions was during the visit of the Honourable Chief Minister to the Chittoor Campus, where he successfully coordinated all engineering support and oversaw the construction of a temporary helipad, all within a short and pressing timeline.

What truly sets Mr. Ananda Kumar apart is not only his technical skill but his spiritual maturity and quiet strength. A man of deep Christian faith, he is known for his humility, team-building spirit, and encouragement of younger colleagues. He has consistently modelled servant leadership—mentoring, listening, and leading by example.

His personal life reflects the same values. His wife, Mrs. Esther, is a nurse working in the UK. Their elder son, Isaac Paul, completed his master's in Medical Biotechnology in Australia and is preparing for the next phase of his career. Their younger son, Ebenezer, recently completed his B.Sc. in Radiodiagnosis and Imaging from CMC and is currently working under a two-year bond. As Mr. Ananda Kumar enters retirement, we honour a life of faith-driven service, quiet leadership, and deep commitment to the mission of CMC. His legacy lies not only in the buildings he helped construct but in the lives he has shaped and the values he upheld.

We thank him wholeheartedly and pray God's abundant blessings on him and his family in this new chapter.

OPTAA Reunion 2025

A Two-Day Celebration of Knowledge, Legacy, and Fellowship at CMC Vellore



The Occupational and Physiotherapy Alumni Association (OPTAA) hosted a two-day reunion from July 11th and 12th, 2025, at CMC Vellore. The event united alumni from multiple generations, celebrating the profession's achievements and looking ahead to its future.

The reunion commenced on July 11th with a Continuing Medical Education programme(CME), attended by the occupational and physiotherapy students and faculty, to enhance clinical skills and encourage innovative practices among physiotherapy and occupational therapy professionals. Moderated by Mr. David V Samuel (2001 PT), the CME featured expert speakers covering critical topics in the rehabilitation field:

- Mr. Charles Premkumar Joseph (1994 PT), an independent home care practitioner, opened the day with insights on 'Pain Perspectives for Rehab Professionals Shifts in Trends', drawing attention to evolving therapeutic approaches. His practical insights on evolving, holistic, transdisciplinary approaches to pain management sparked thoughtful engagement during the Q & A.
- Ms. Mukteshwari Bosco (1983 OT), founder of Healing Fields Foundation, inspired attendees with her talk on 'Beyond the Degree: Career Pathways after BPT and BOT', encouraging therapists to explore diverse roles in healthcare, emphasising unconventional career trajectories and the expanding role of therapists in public health and entrepreneurship.
- Community-focused discussions included talks by Mr. Rabindran Isaac (1983 OT), who presented models and challenges in 'Community-Based Rehabilitation in the Indian Context', based on his years of experience at the Spastics Society of Karnataka, Bengaluru.
- Mr. Reuban Daniel Chandrasekaran (2001 PT) highlighted his operational leadership at PACT, INDIA, through the talk 'Community-Based Inclusive Development'.
- Evidence-based clinical practice was discussed by Dr. Abraham Samuel Babu (2001 PT), Associate Professor at Manipal Academy of Higher Education, during his talk on 'Translating Research into Practice', offering actionable strategies for young clinicians.
- Dr. Preethy Sarah Samuel (1994 OT), Associate Professor, Wayne State University, Detroit, closed the session with a reflective talk on 'The Value of Theoretical Frameworks in Practice' emphasising their relevance to patient-centred care.



The evening of July 11 saw an interactive panel discussion between senior administrators and alumni. Ms. Margaret Christy, President of OPTAA, opened the evening with a welcome address. Dr. Vikram Mathews, Director of CMC Vellore, officially inaugurated the gathering, emphasising the significance of alumni contributions in shaping healthcare practices nationwide. American Heart Association - Advanced Cardiac Life Support (AHA ACLS) Provider-level Course Conducted

The AHA-ACLS provider level course was held on the 11th & 12th July 2025. This course is designed for healthcare professionals—such as doctors, nurses, and paramedics—who provide advanced life support to critically ill adults, going beyond basic life support, focusing on care during the stabilisation and transport phases of adult medical emergencies. This course, valid internationally, is accredited by the American Heart Association. As per the AHA guidelines, the course has a strict restriction of 24 participants. The ACLS faculty were Dr. Ekta Rai, Dr. Anand Babu Medidi, and Dr. Bernice Theodore, Department of Anaesthesia; Dr. Atul More, MICU Department & Dr. Bennett Philip, Department of Medicine. Dr. Leah Raju George from Anaesthesia, Dr. Ramya I from Medicine & Dr. Anjali R from Emergency Medicine are under Faculty monitoring. 18 delegates actively participated in this ACLS course.
