Dr. Urmi Ghosh retired after 32 years of dedicated service at Christian Medical College Vellore. Dr. Urmi has had a long and remarkable journey in Paediatrics, one defined by clinical excellence, compassion, teaching, service, and, above all, a deep commitment to children. Though she hails from West Bengal; Tamil Nadu has been her home for most of her life, and CMC Vellore has been an integral part of her personal and professional journey.

Dr. Urmi belongs to the undergraduate batch of 1985. She completed her Diploma in Child Health as well as Diplomate of the National Board of Examination in Paediatrics from CMC Vellore. She joined the Department of Paediatrics as a Tutor in 1994 and has remained an integral part of the Department ever since. Over the years, she progressed through the academic ranks and retired in May 2026 as Professor of Paediatrics.

Dr. Urmi is an excellent paediatrician, known particularly for her meticulous history taking and thorough clinical examination. She has always believed in basics listening carefully, observing closely, examining thoroughly, and putting together the clinical picture before arriving at a diagnosis. Her approach has always been thoughtful when it comes to patient care. Her compassion, patience, and genuine concern for children and their families have been among her most admired qualities. Dr. Urmi has been a dedicated and much-loved teacher as her work is based on sound clinical reasoning. Many students, particularly postgraduate learners, have acknowledged the significant impact of her teaching in their academic journey.

She approached every task with extraordinary attention to detail. Nothing was done casually; everything was thought through carefully and completed with sincerity and precision. Dr. Urmi has made significant contribution to undergraduate medical education in Paediatrics. Her meticulous approach to academic planning and her commitment to structured learning were evident well before the introduction of the National Medical Commission's (NMC) Competency-Based Undergraduate Curriculum. The detailed logbook, documenting the various aspects of Paediatric training at CMC, stands as an example of comprehensive and systematic clinical training.

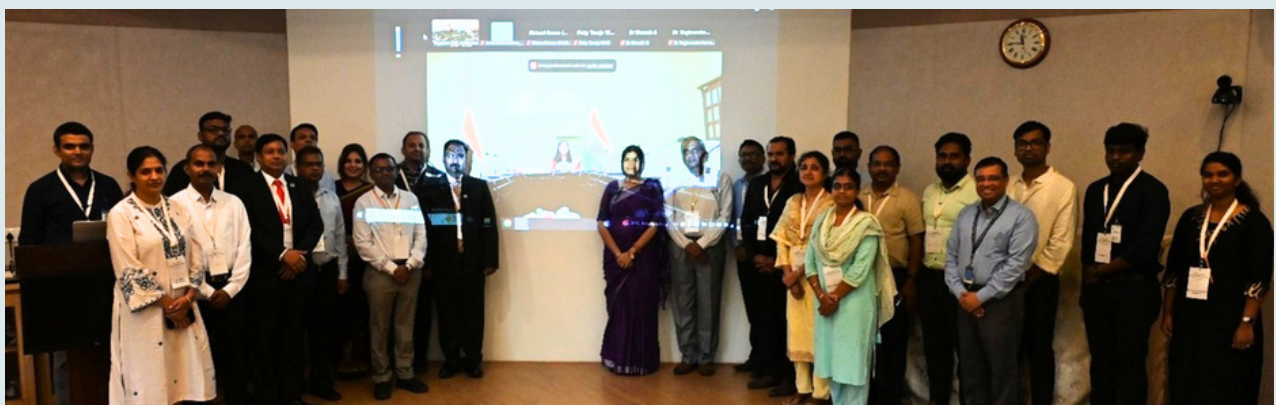

CMC Vellore Hosted the First National Workshop on Poison Information Centres



CMC Vellore hosted the first National Workshop on Poison Information Centres from 20th - 22nd August 2026. The workshop was jointly organised by the National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC), Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, the WHO India Country Office and the Poison Control Center, CMC Vellore.

The workshop brought together representatives from Poison Information Centres across India and leading international Poison Centers, key Government of India ministries, national authorities including NDMA and NDRF, WHO, academic institutions and other stakeholders. Discussions focused on developing consensus on key operational aspects and strengthening poison information services across India.

The event also marked the formal handover of CMC Vellore Poison Control Centre's designation by NCDC, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, as a Centre of Excellence for Snakebite Envenoming.

CMC Vellore's Poison Control Center is a national-level facility, handling over 25,000 poisoning and envenoming enquiries annually, in addition to extensive training, research and community outreach. The information service is integrated with a dedicated Clinical Toxicology Unit and supported by institutional laboratory services.

Department of Ophthalmology Hosts Guest Lecture and Masterclass Workshop on Premium IOLs in Cataract Surgery

Department of Ophthalmology Hosts Guest Lecture and Masterclass Workshop on Premium IOLs in Cataract Surgery. The Department of Ophthalmology, Christian Medical College Vellore organised a Guest Lecture and Advanced Workshop on "Premium Intraocular Lenses (IOLs)" on August 29, 2026. The academic feast brought together faculty, fellows, and postgraduates to explore the latest clinical, diagnostic, and surgical paradigms in advanced cataract and refractive lens surgery.

The morning session commenced with an opening prayer led by Dr. Anika Amirtanand, followed by an introduction of the guest faculty by Dr. Jeyanth Rose. Dr. Anurag Mishra, currently serves as Director of RREH, Cuttack, and is a seasoned Ophthalmic surgeon with over 100 live surgical demonstrations and extensive academic contributions across the Asia-Pacific, Dr. Mishra delivered a comprehensive guest lecture covering the core optics of Toric, Extended Depth of Focus (EDOF), and Trifocal IOLs. His talk systematically addressed nuanced patient selection, personality screening, neuroadaptation evaluation, and surgical blueprints for long-term rotational and visual stability. The lecture concluded with an interactive Q&A session moderated by Dr. Alo.

The mid-morning academic workshop, designed specifically for Professors and Associate professors, was convened in the Board Room by Dr. Jeyanth Rose, Dr. Sanita Korah and Dr. Anupriya Arthur, and chaired by Dr. Anurag Mishra. Structured around modular diagnostic checklists and interactive clinical case scenarios, Live demonstration of patient evaluation focusing on visual demands, lifestyle needs, ocular contraindications, and personality types were chaptered in detail. Hands-on toric IOL planning and case debugging scenarios were created for translational benefit.

The programme then transitioned to the operating room, where Dr. Anurag Mishra performed a live surgical demonstration of a Vivinex Gemetric Toric Trifocal IOL implantation, showcasing precise preoperative axis marking, surgical docking, intraoperative toric alignment, and capsular bag stability manoeuvres. Dr. Sheeja Susan John, Head of Ophthalmology, delivered the vote of thanks and handed over a special CMC memento bearing the Mary Taber Schell Arch to Dr. Anurag Mishra for the academic fest.
